Crocker Art Museum: The Crocker Art Museum, formerly the E. B. Crocker Art Gallery, founded in 1885, is the oldest art museum west of the Mississippi River. Located in Sacramento, California, the Museum holds one of the state's premier collections of Californian art.

Children's Discovery Museum: Sacramento Children's Museum is a children's museum in Rancho Cordova near Sacramento, California. SCM is a destination for children to inspire, create and explore.

Railroad Museum: The California State Railroad Museum is a museum in the state park system of California, USA, interpreting the role of the "iron horse" in connecting California to the rest of the nation.

Living History Museum: Sacramento History Museum is the only museum devoted to Sacramento, California and California Gold Rush history.
